# Executive Director's Summary





Our fourth year in operation proved to be our most financially successful generating almost \$24,000 in sales and donations.

This year we added a Fall Plant Sale Fundraiser in October that was perfectly timed for the arrival of Hurricane Ian. Our Caterpillar Support Program was not able to help as many applicants as the previous year due to prolonged heat and drought. We performed 41 Yard Consultations, a 372% increase from 2021!

Our 6th Annual Open House & Plant Swap once again was blessed with ideal weather. We donated \$500 (100 plants) on our Free Plant Table. The Plant Swap was the most successful it has ever been.

The foundation of the NC Under-reported County Mothing Project was made. For 2023 the project will be open to participants to help us conduct moth surveys.

We formalized our Plant Donation Program and created an application process and have so far pledged to donate 177 plants in 2023.

Our attendance at events for community outreach was comparable to pre-Covid years. We sold out spaces for a Raise a Caterpillar workshop in September.




